TYCOON opened clear to dictate terms, turned back the bid of LET TH KITTEN PURR midway through the second turn, shook loose and widened through the drive. SOKITUMI SAMURAI was in tight early, settled saving ground, took closer order after a half, got through entering the stretch, was unable to menace the winner but kept on well to earn the place. LET TH KITTEN PURR tracked the pace three deep, moved up to engage the leader with five-sixteenths to run, weakened during the drive but had enough left to preserve the show. LOVE MAN angled in at once to save ground, shifted out three wide entering the stretch and was making up ground between rivals through the lane. VPERYOD SERYOYA was hustled along five wide in mid pack and went evenly. KUMACANDU was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground but lacked a response when called upon. THIRSTY THURSDAY contended off of the inside to the second turn and dropped out.
