BALLYCLOUGH set the pace three wide in hand, opened clear entering the stretch, was kept to task and widened through the final furlong. MR. FUZZYBOTTOM prompted the pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner after a half, but stayed on fairly well to hold the place. VOODOO DOCTOR attended the pace off of the inside, came three wide but finished evenly and settled for the show. GOLDEN FRONTIER broke a step slow, settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. KEYSTROKE contended four wide to the final furlong and weakened. G. W.'S D'ORO was unhurried into stride, lagged at the tail of the field, angled out but failed to threaten. AMMAROO was hustled along four wide for a half and dropped out.
