Footnotes

SILENT CRYSTAL, rated near the inside from early on, eased out four wide concluding the backstretch, moved to the fore just prior to going six furlongs, swerved out suddenly approaching the three-sixteenths pole bumping with SHAWNEE SUNRISE forcing that one out into FLYING MARLIN, lost the lead, then dug in gamely through the late stages to prevail. FLYING MARLIN, unhurried early, commenced a sweeping rally five or six wide midway on the far turn, was bumped and forced out nearing the three-sixteenths pole by SHAWNEE SUNRISE when that one was forced out by SILENT CRYSTAL, recovered to gain a slim advantage but couldn't contain SILENT CRYSTAL'S final surge. MISS GOOSEBUMPS, angled inside soon after the start, was outrun to the stretch, came out nine wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. SHAWNEE SUNRISE, never far back while following the leader under light rating four or five wide, moved after SILENT CRYSTAL while outside that one into the stretch, was bumped and forced out into FLYING MARLIN approaching the three-sixteenths pole by SILENT CRYSTAL, then flattened out when straightened for the drive. SUGAR DIPPED, unhurried for a half, made a run seven wide at the quarter-mile ground, angled near the inside when straightened into the lane, gained almost even terms for the last eighth but failed to sustain the needed momentum. LIPSTICK TRACES, well placed early, lost position on the backstretch and around the far turn, was checked in the upper stretch while near the inside, then failed to menace. SYNERGISTIC, well placed near the inside for six furlongs, weakened thereafter. SUNSET SKIES gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace for almost three-quarters and tired. AZIMUT wasn't a factor. WHEN I GROW UP, used early to gain a forward position four wide, raced prominently for six furlongs and tired. Following a stewards' inquiry and foul claim lodged by the rider of SHAWNEE

SUNRISE against SILENT CRYSTAL for alleged interference in the upper stretch, the stewards disqualified SILENT CRYSTAL and placed her fourth.
