LIMITED ENTRY angled in early to press front-running NO CASH three or four wide, took over from that one approaching the final furlong and drew away under hand urging. NO CASH exchanged bumps with MORE THAN PERFECT at the start, gained the lead near the inside, made the pace while battling inside the winner to the lane and couldn't match strides in the drive as second best. DOMESTIC ARTS, nicely placed in behind the dueling leaders early, swerved out and in suddenly when appearing green at the three-sixteenths pole, then flattened out. ROYAL FUDGE, checked after the start, raced near the inside most of the way and was empty the last eighth. CAPE COUNTY, three or four wide, failed to rally. MORE THAN PERFECT leaned in exchanging bumps with NO CASH at the start, raced in contention in behind the leaders to the lane and weakened. MONEYBACKGUARANTEE, sluggish early, was outrun. LIBERTY BELLAH, four or five wide, wasn't a factor.
