EXHI opened clear to dictate terms, turned back the bid of DEAN'S KITTEN leaving the second turn, opened clear nearing the furlong marker and maintained a safe advantage. DEAN'S KITTEN tracked the pace three deep, moved up to engage EXHI with three furlongs to run, was unable to match strides with that one but stayed on well to earn the place. MISTER MARTI GRAS was allowed to settle four wide, came five wide and was along in time to earn the show. RESEARCHER attended the pace along the inside, angled out entering the stretch and loomed a danger but lacked the needed late response. STAY PUT broke a step slow, shifted to the outside on the first turn, pulled to contention four wide, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out.
