MIDWAY , well in hand while tracking the dueling leaders from near the inside, eased out a bit to advance four wide leaving the backstretch, took over just prior to going six furlongs, drew off into the stretch under his own power, then was ridden out to widen. BIM'S BABY BUN settled inside early, saved ground while edging closer on the far turn, moved between foes into the lane, leaned in bumping with ONEOFTHEBIRDBOYS at the eighth pole, then continued on as second best. ONEOFTHEBIRDBOYS, never far back and saving ground much of the way, was bumped entering the stretch by BIM'S BABY RUN, then was empty the last eighth RISKY CAT, well placed early, raced between rivals on the backstretch, was checked at the half-mile ground, continued forwardly to the stretch after moving out four wide but flattened out the last eighth. STYLISH DANCER gained a slight lead early, edged near the inside, dueled with HONEAGLE, lost the edge to the winner on the far turn, continued in closest attendance to MIDWAY ROAD into the stretch and faltered. AKANTI (IRE) moved out seven wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit on the far turn but failed to menace. HONEAGLE went up early to contest the pace outside of STYLISH DANCER, held on well until the end of the backstretch and weakened. SHOWDOWN followed the leaders in a striking position five wide, held on well until the end of the backstretch, fell back, was pulled up before going six furlongs, then vanned off.
