Footnotes

LILAC QUEEN (GER), between horses early while unhurried, moved up four or five wide while continuing under wraps approaching the final turn, commenced a sweeping five wide run nearing the stretch, took over when straightened for the drive, moved clear at the furlong grounds, then widened a bit thereafter under hand urging. BEYOND THE WAVES, never far back while racing in behind rivals three wide, followed the winner from the outside six abreast into the stretch and outgamed SAN DARE for second while unable to menace LILAC QUEEN (GER). SAN DARE, eased back near the inside early, moved out five or six wide on the backstretch, circled nine or 10 wide into the stretch and was slowly gaining late. DANCING (GB), forwardly placed from early on while near the inside between rivals, angled to the rail for the drive, loomed a solid threat but failed to respond. NEW ECONOMY, reserved near the inside soon after the start, saved ground while edging closer on the final turn, came out between rivals five or six wide for the drive and failed to offer a late response while dead heating for fifth with SOMETHING VENTURED. The latter stalked front-running HI TECH HONEYMOON from early on, challenged just before going a mile, gained a slim, brief lead a quarter-mile out, then weakened in the drive to finish on even terms with NEW ECONOMY. SPLENDEUR (FR) settled in a striking position four or five wide, continued in contention to the stretch and flattened out. SUNSTONE (GB), reluctant to load into the gate, raced three or four wide while outrun early, reached contention a quarter-mile out, came out nine wide for the drive and failed to offer a late response. HI

TECH HONEYCOMB gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace for nearly 10 furlongs while dueling much of the way and faltered. DAISYAGO, well placed under light rating from early on, made a solid bid from the rail upon going a mile but weakened approaching the stretch.
