 MIDST sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and increased her lead under steady urging. TRULY A MYTH closest to the pace, moved out three wide late on the turn, could not run with the winner late but was clearly second best. LADY SILVER SONG drifted in at the start bumping RISING BAROMETER, was straightened to race within striking distance in the four path but had no late bid. TRIBECKY close up from the start, raced four wide into the stretch and tired. GIRL IN THE CITY bumped at the start, was no threat. JODY SLEW four wide midway through the turn, could not menace. SEND ROSE THECHECK bumped at the start, was outrun. LADY O'DWYER was no threat. NIGHT STROLL was outrun while off the rail. RISING BAROMETER bumped at the start, raced six wide midway through the turn and was no factor. SIGH was outrun while wide.
