GEFEST sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail and stayed clear under steady urging. AMEN KITTEN outrun for a half, made a run four wide on the second turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. DORSETT close up from the start, saved ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. EL JEFE GRANDE within striking distance, raced in the four path on the second turn and had nothing left late. SQUALL KING outrun early, raced four wide on the second turn and was no threat. ENDURANCE closest to the pace off the inside, raced in the three path on the second turn and tired. BOLD DANCE was outrun. ERIUGENA (IRE) hopped at the start, was out sprinted early and never was a factor. DIPSY DREW within striking distance, was in the three path on the second turn and gave way. JACK N JOHN prominent three wide, faded.
