Footnotes

RENA STARLIGHT angled in early when outrun, made a good four wide middle move, challenged with a furlong to go and proved narrowly best. CONTESSA'S VOYAGE outrun early, made a good four wide run after a half, challenged leaving the second turn, drifted in with a furlong to go and was outfinished. ENGLISH NOTES forwardly placed three wide, challenged on the second turn, battled into the stretch and tired. MILLENNIUM STAR forced the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, gained a short lead on the second turn, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. CLARE'S BERNARDINE steadied into the first turn in traffic, raced within striking distance off the inside and could not threaten late. FLASHY AMERICAN within reach early three wide, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn and had nothing left late. SISTER C close up early along the inside, tired. DAZZLETOWN steadied early, recovered to be prominent four wide, held on well for five furlongs and faded. ADAMAS set the pace inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. OURNAUGHTYESCAPADE unseated her rider and ran off a short distance prior to being loaded in the gate then was outrun. SAINT AGGIE forwardly placed three wide, stopped.
