Footnotes

HIGH DIVA, never far back while following the leaders three or four wide, rallied from that position nearing the stretch, wrested command, opened a clear lead, then was kept to her task. HOSAN FORTIES maneuvered inward early, remained in behind horses until approaching the final quarter, came to rally from between foes five wide for the drive and couldn't offer the needed late response. HOIST THE STAR, outrun for a half while in behind foes near the inside, came out eight or nine wide for the drive and found her best stride late. CHAP UP came out at the break bumping SPICE ISLAND, was outrun until the stretch, worked her way between foes to reach contention a furlong out but could gain only slightly at the end. SPANISH LASS, outsprinted early, raced in behind horses, came off the inside for the drive and offered a minor gain while not a threat. VAL U ME, near the inside much of the way, failed to rally. SUAVE CHICK was able to work her way inward early, raced in contention behind the leaders to the stretch, came out six wide for the drive, then flattened out when the test came. BALLADO'S HALO gained the lead inside early, made the pace until the stretch and weakened thereafter. SPREADING THE NEWS chased front-running BALLADO'S HALO from early on, raced forwardly until approaching the stretch and tired. SPICE ISLAND, bumped at the start by CHAP UP, was checked and shuffled back, then never was prominent. SHOP GIRL, six wide on the backstretch, continued off the inside the remainder and faded in the drive. SMILING SKY, forwardly placed in behind rivals for a half, weakened nearing the stretch.
