Footnotes

LEAR'S PRINCESS, never far back, made a steady run five wide leaving the turn, engaged front-running MS SABBATICAL at the furlong grounds, brushed with that one about the sixteenth pole. At that point, the rider misjudged the finish line, rose prematurely, then, when the rider of MS. SABBATICAL also misjudged the wire and rose in the saddle, earned the nod on the wire while galloping out. MS. SABBATICAL gained slight edge from the three path, battled with PURE SLIK, shook off that one in the upper stretch, was engaged by the winner in the upper stretch, brushed with LEAR'S PRINCESS at the sixteenth pole. Soon afterwards, the rider misjudged the wire rising prematurely in the iron and lost the photo when galloping out to the proper finish line. PURE SILK contested the pace outside of MS. SABBATICAL to the lane, dropped near the inside and was empty. BLOCK, reserved between foes early, advanced five wide to reach contention at the furlong grounds but lacked a further account. TUCKAHOE ROAD, outrun for a half, made a five wide run into the final furlong but failed to continue. EXTRA INNINGS, near the inside, weakened after five furlongs. BELLA COACHELLA raced in contention between foes to the final quarter and tired. BEST REGARDS was finished on the turn. MISS EMMY faded midway on the turn. LA LA LOLA used near the inside early, tired upon going a half.
