SUMMER BREEZING stalked the pace, launched his bid four wide, reeled in JOES BLAZING AARON nearing the furlong marker and edged clear. GHOST IS CLEAR was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, angled out entering the stretch and kicked on well to earn the place. ARTEST settled in hand, moved up four wide to make a mild bid entering the stretch, but weakened during the drive and was all out to earn the show. JOES BLAZING AARON was away alertly, set a clear pace off of the inside, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. FLEET BEAT broke slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out leaving the turn but lacked a response when called upon. SILVER SUMMATION saved ground to no avail. HAMILTONIAN broke through the gate, chased three wide for a half and dropped out.
