Footnotes

GRAND PORTEGE, bumped at the start by LA BARONESS and never far back, raced four or five wide, advanced steadily leaving the turn, engaged front-running TRICKS AFTER DARK at the furlong grounds and bested her in a stiff drive. TRICKS AFTER DARK, within easy striking distance, moved four wide to gain a narrow advantage, then was outfinished in a good try. GALA REGATTA gained the lead inside upon going a sixteenth, held a slight edge to the stretch and weakened. LA BARONESS leaned in at the start bumping GRAND PORTEGE, raced in contention seven wide early, edged in around the turn, remained within striking distance into the stretch and flattened out. CHOCOLATKISS, eight wide on the backstretch, edged near the inside on the turn and couldn't threaten while improving position. HAIDAR tired approaching the stretch while near the inside. UNIFIER, briefly in front after the start, continued in contention for three furlongs off the inside and tired. RUNAWAY GREY, unruly in the gate prior to the start and sluggish to start, never was close. HOPE AND COPE, also broke sluggishly and was outrun. TOY LAKE, briefly in front between foes after the start, offered only brief speed.
