Footnotes

DEPECHE CHAT angled in to set the pace, shook clear entering the stretch and held gamely. PERFECT AFLEET disputed the pace three wide, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. SETON HALL settled between horses, shifted out entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to bridge the gap. DUBAI ECHO settled saving ground, moved out a bit entering the stretch, split horses and improved position. HA LONG BAY was allowed to settle near the tail of the field between horses, swung to the outside entering the stretch but found his best stride too late. PURGENALITY was unhurried into stride, angled out and finished with a belated gain. LACONIC settled along the inside, got through and finished with a mild rally. POSITIVE SIDE was close up four wide to the stretch and faded. RIVENDELL was nearest the pace three wide, but tired between horses entering the stretch and retreated. SIR MCINTYRE was forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs and tired. TRAGIC MAGIC made a middle move six wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. RIVER LEMON lagged well back and failed to respond.
