ALUMNI HALL went up early to press front-running OLE FAUNTY under light rating, inched to the front just prior to going six furlongs, opened a clear advantage entering the stretch and was kept to his task. PIES PROSPECT, well placed in behind the leaders from early on, was asked for a bit more leaving the three-furlong marker, eased out between foes entering the stretch four wide, loomed prominently outside the winner through the drive, couldn't offer the needed response but was superior to the rest. GO NOW leaned in after the break lightly bumping with FORMAL ATTIRE, settled, near the inside, raced three wide on the backstretch, began to edge closer entering the far turn when near the rail, moved out three or four wide entering the stretch and improved position while unable to challenge the top two. COLONIAL COLONY, within easy striking distance and three wide until nearing the final quarter, maneuvered out five or six wide for the drive, couldn't menace and was checked alongside FORMAL ATTIRE when that one broke down leaving the eighth pole. OLE FAUNTY gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace under pressure from the winner for nearly six furlongs and weakened. BEST MINISTER came out at the start exchanging bumps with NIGON, raced five wide most of the way and failed to menace. NIIGON bobbed lightly at the start and leaned in bumping with BEST MINISTER, raced off the inside and tired on the far turn. FORMAL ATTIRE, lightly bumped at the start by GO NOW when that one leaned in, stalked the pace four wide, came slightly wider into the lane, broke down just after the stretch call and was pulled up.
