RODDICKTON reserved off the rail, made a good middle move in the two path, angled out for the drive, challenged with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. PAPA W BODIE forced the pace off the inside while in hand, challenged before a half, battled into the final furlong and held on for the place. A. P. RIDGE within striking distance along the inside, was boxed in from midway through the second turn to the furlong marker, angled out and finished willingly late. DR. ALEX outrun while off the inside, moved out four wide late on the second turn and lacked a closing bid. WAJIR ON ME reserved along the inside, had little left late. COMMANDEERED vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. WHIRLING THUNDER prompted the pace three wide and gave way.
