CASUARINA gained a slight edge inside early while dueling with MISS HELEN WHEELS and PRINCESS FALINA, was eased back entering the backstretch while continuing inside, moved out four wide upon going a half, regained the advantage just after going six furlongs when put to a drive, was well clear into the lane and increased her margin under strong handling. FUTURES MARKET broke to the outside, bumped POSSIBLY SILVER and forced that one out, was unhurried, edged up between foes on the far turn, continued five wide into the stretch and was up for the place. PRINCESS FALINA forced the pace from early on while three abreast, reached the front briefly between calls early on the backstretch, lost the edge back to MISS HELEN WHEELS, regained a slight advantage just before going six furlongs and weakened soon after. BELLE'S BLAZE had no rally. POSSIBLY SILVER, bumped at the start by FUTURES MARKET and forced out, wasn't a factor. MISS HELEN WHEELS contested the pace from early on while between rivals, stuck her head in front before going a half, held on well for three-quarters and tired.
