CATCHING REYS attended the pace along the inside, slipped through entering the stretch and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. PISKACHA was hustled along four wide, steadied nearing the quarter pole when MY ROXY came out, was floated out through the drive, but kept on gamely and was gaining with every stride. SWEET MOONBEAM vied for the lead between horses, weakened slightly following a prolonged drive and grudgingly gave way. RAHY GIRL was close up four wide, poked her head in front briefly but flattened during the drive. JAZIL'S SONG was slow into stride, forced wide on the turn, came eight wide and was making up ground too late. MY ROXY contended off of the inside, angled out leaving the turn to find room but lacked the needed late response. A. P. AZERIN broke slow, rushed to contention between horses, angled out six wide leaving the turn, veered in from right handed urging, was straitened away and was gaining between rivals. LA STUPENDA settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. HANNAH'S HOLIDAY was hustled along four wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. SUGAR KUWALSKI disputed the pace off of the inside, but faltered from between foes in the final furlong and faded. TAPIT TO ME was hustled along four wide, steadied off heels near the quarter pole and showed little thereafter.
