Footnotes

LOOKS PURRRFECT settled in hand between horses while never far back, moved up three wide leaving the second turn, wore down the leaders and edged clear late. CALIPARI'S KITTEN stalked the pace two wide, drew even entering the stretch, brushed with MARCO'S FLING near the eighth pole when that one came out, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. IWANNAIWANNAIWANNA settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch, but found his best stride too late. MARCO'S FLING opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch, drifted out brushing CALIPARI'S KITTEN a furlong out and weakened in the drive. EYE FOR AN EYE was hustled along four wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. GHOSTWALKING was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and faded. BUCKY was caught in tight entering the first turn, settled in hand, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. INK was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. EAST COAST TRAIL made a middle move six wide but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated. YOUTH'S PRIDE was close up four wide to the second turn and stopped.
