Footnotes

SAINT WAKI settled near the inside early, rallied along the rail on the turn, came out three wide in tight quarters leaving the eighth pole, placed MORE DAYLIGHT in a bit tight, then drove clear. DEFY LOGIC broke a step slow, was unhurried while racing in behind horses, angled five or six wide leaving the turn, was bumped by INVOLVEMENT when that one came out leaving the eighth pole and gamely earned second. SHADOW HAWK moved to the fore near the inside early, made the pace into deep stretch and weakened. INVOLVEMENT chased front-running SHADOW HAWK from early on while four wide, came in leaving the furlong grounds bumping repeatedly with MORE DAYLIGHT, came out soon after and bumped DEFY LOGIC, then flattened out. MORE DAYLIGHT, never far back, raced near the inside, lacked room in the upper stretch, was in tight leaving the eighth pole, then was finished when bumped repeatedly by INVOLVEMENT soon after. LETTER OF CREDIT broke in front, raced five or six wide and tired. CAT RIDGE, outrun to the stretch, improved position but wasn't a threat. STOKER wasn't a factor. KING TUTTA raced forwardly five wide to the turn and weakened. LORD FOXCROFT, in contention five or six wide to the stretch, weakened thereafter. MACKINAW BAY gave way early, wasn't persevered with in the drive and was distanced.
