Footnotes

EUROSILVER reserved early when within striking distance, accelerated quickly after six furlongs when asked, caught the leader approaching the furlong marker and drew off under steady handling. TIGER HUNT outran early, advanced in traffic on the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive, split rivals in deep stretch and was up for the place. LIMEHOUSE within striking distance along the inside, angled out entering the stretch for room but had no late bid. VALUE PLUS steadied from inside the leader late on the first turn, recovered, challenged outside that one after five furlongs, gained a short lead approaching the stretch but tired in the final furlong. VICTORY LIGHT outran early when unhurried, made a good four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. THE CLIFF'S EDGE carried in at the start, was far back when reserved, launched his rally after six furlongs, made a good gain thereafter but went evenly late. COOPERATION set the early pace near the inside, moved to the rail for the second turn, held on well to the furlong marker and tired. WAR IMAGE carried in at the start, was outrun early and was no factor. DISTRESSED DEBT came in a bit entering the first turn placing MASS MEDIA in tight, pressed the early pace four wide, held on well to the final quarter and tired. MASS MEDIA came in a bit early, drifted wide after steadying entering the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance, moved in to the three path for the second turn and stopped. DESERT PATROL forwardly placed three wide, stopped badly.
