Footnotes

CASEY'S ON CALL forced the pace four wide, moved in a path midway through the turn, responded to pressure in the stretch and proved narrowly best in the prolonged drive. TROY G. vied for the lead off the inside, battled through the stretch and just missed. BEETHOVEN outrun early, split rivals entering the turn, angled out four wide with a bit less than three furlongs to go then closed well on the outside to just miss. GENERAL QUARTERS close up along the inside, maintained a forward position to midstretch and tired. TAMBORIM never far back three wide, moved four wide approaching the stretch and tired. CROWN THE CHIEF forced in at the start, pressed the early pace inside and faded. HONGKONG SUPERSTAR outsprinted early, raced in the four path on the turn and could not menace. MESA GOLD wide on the turn, was no factor. CLASSY WONDER drifted in at the start carrying CROWN THE CHIEF IN, raced within striking distance off the rail and faded. ELEGANT CAD was outrun. IVAN IVAN forced the pace between rivals and faded. PROMISE ME MERLOT had speed for a half.
