By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,000 to enter and start; with \$400,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Fillies, 118 lbs.; Colts and Geldings, 121 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lane's End Breeders' Futurity will be limited to fourteen. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The first four finishers in the Lane's End Breeders' Futurity are automatically made eligible for the Toyota Blue Grass Stakes of 2003 as to nomination fee. Closed Wednesday, September 25, 2002 with 27 nominations.

**Footnotes**

SKY MESA, between rivals into the first turn, eased out four wide to press front-running TRUCKLE FEATURE, was asked to pick up the pace a bit leaving the backstretch, inched after the leader, took over just after going six furlongs, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and was kept busy the remainder. LONE STAR SKY, within easy striking distance and between foes three or four wide for a half, continued three or four wide into the stretch and couldn't challenge the winner while fully extended. TRUCKLE FEATURE bobbed at the start and drifted out bumping SUPER FROLIC, moved to the fore soon after, raced near the inside, made the pace for six furlongs, lost the advantage to the winner and weakened. TITO'S BEAU, in contention and saving ground most of the way, was empty the last eighth. SUPER FROLIC, bumped at the start and forced out a bit, raced four or five wide while unhurried, was put to a drive three furlongs out, continued off the inside and couldn't menace. PRIVATE GOLD, in contention to the end of the backstretch while four or five wide, faded gradually after six furlongs.
