FLYING JAZZ, outrun until approaching the stretch and racing near the inside, continued inside into the lane, angled out four wide at the furlong grounds and finished fast under strong handling to edge clear late. TEN FORTY EASY vied for the lead inside from early on, battled with OFFLEE WILD, was headed by that one on the turn, regained a clear advantage in the upper stretch, then wasn't a match for the winner late. INDIANA EXPRESS, steadied after the start when caught in tight quarters, was outrun four or five wide until the stretch, came out seven wide for the drive and closed a late gap. OFFLEE WILD went up soon after the break to contest the pace outside of TEN FORTY EASY, headed that one on the turn, lost the edge back to that one soon after and weakened in the drive. BAY RAIDER moved inside concluding the backstretch, raced within easy striking distance into the stretch and was empty when the test came. MAGICAL MOMENT drifted in soon after the start, raced in contention two or three wide into the stretch and flattened out. DEVIL'S TRIANGLE stalked the pace four wide into the stretch and faltered. HOT HAND went to his knees at the start and was finished upon going al half. ABYSSINIAN wasn't a factor. HATTON CROSS drifted in at the break tightening it up on INDIANA EXPRESS and tired on the turn. SO COMPELLING was outrun.
