Footnotes

TAKE CHARGE LADY worked her way nicely to the rail prior to reaching the first turn, raced under light rating, continued inside while rallying entering the stretch, got through smoothly inside YOU to reach the front at the three-sixteenths pole, then continued under energetic handling to prove clearly best. YOU gained the lead early, moved in to race two or three wide, made the pace into the stretch and wasn't a match for TAKE CHARGE LADY when straightened for the drive as second best. PRINTemps (CHI), outrun into the backstretch, reached contention beginning the far turn while in behind rivals, came out six wide to make a serious run approaching the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. DANCETHRUTHEDAWN, away well, quickly settled four wide, dropped in behind foes on the far turn, came out again to make a mild bid four or five wide into the upper stretch but lacked a serious late account. ATELIER settled behind horses early, moved out three wide between rivals on the backstretch, was asked for her best at the quarter-mile ground but flattened out when straightened for the drive. VICTORY RIDE went up early to press front-running YOUR four wide, raced forwardly for six furlongs and weakened gradually. LAKENHEATH, well placed early while four wide, moved six wide on the backstretch, continued within easy striking distance until approaching the stretch and tired.
