OFF DUTY went up early to press front-running INDIAN CHANT four wide, took over in the upper stretch, then was kept to his task to hold sway. REBELLION (GB), never far back, came out from between foes five wide when straightened for the drive and was going well at the end. SAINT ANDDAN, four or five wide and never far back, failed to produce the needed late response. INDIAN CHANT moved to the fore three or four wide, made the pace into the upper stretch and weakened. HE LOVES ME NOT, in a challenging position to the stretch five wide, angled eight wide for the drive and couldn't offer a serious late threat. CONNECTIONS, well placed inside into the upper stretch, flattened out when the test came. MUSEEB, away in front and well placed off the inside, was forced to take up sharply nearing the half-mile ground when TEUFLESBERG was pulled up lame in front of him, recovered to race within striking distance to the stretch and was empty in the drive. MARKUM, steadied sharply and angled around TEUFLESBERG when that one was pulled up, was outrun to the lane, came out ten wide for the drive and couldn't menace. COWBOY HARDWARE, sluggish to start and outrun, was wide in the stretch run. TEUFLESBERG, forwardly placed four or five wide early, took a bad step before going a quarter, was pulled up lame and vanned off.
