TEPIN settled in hand four wide, split rivals entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. ADELLUSION was unhurried into stride, moved up four wide through the turn, tipped out six wide and continued on well to prove second best. HOMESICK ANGEL settled saving ground, shifted out leaving the turn, was bottled up in traffic entering the stretch, found a narrow seam between rivals and was along for the show. READY PLAYER ONE broke in the air to get away slow, was allowed to settle, came five wide and loomed a danger with a furlong to run but failed to sustain the drive. BRAD'S RUBY opened clear to set the pace, was collared between rivals with a furlong to run and gave way. UNION PRAYER was forwardly placed three wide, but came up empty between foes entering the stretch and retreated. DUCASA broke slow, rushed to contention between horses, but came up empty after five furlongs and dropped out. BABY LIS failed to respond. SLEW CITY PLEASURE saved ground to no avail.
