Footnotes

REGENT SPIRIT gained the lead early, managed a slight edge while dueling, kicked clear in the upper stretch, drifted out about the sixteenth pole, then held GENE POOL safe under energetic hand urging. GENE POOL, up close inside the winner early, was eased back on the turn while racing near the inside between rivals, maneuvered back inside the winner when straightened for the drive and was gaining late. CARSE, outrun for a half, advanced five or six wide into the lane and bested the others. COUSIN PAUL, within easy striking distance near the inside for a half, moved four wide into the lane but was empty late. FORECASTLE stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. OVERLAND TRAIL, well placed early while between foes, continued prominently to the stretch and weakened. ATLANTIC IDOL, up close along the inside for a half, weakened soon after. READILY failed to reach contention. KENTUCKY WARRIOR was outrun and seven or eight wide in the drive. POLARITY never was prominent. GRAND TRAVERSE bobbed at the break, was hustled along to gain a forward position off the inside and faded upon going a half.
