Footnotes

GIO PONTI, rated near the inside from early on, was never far back, came out bumping FIRE LOOKOUT nearing the three-sixteenths pole to secure room, continued three wide, and was going away at the end under mild urging. NOWNOWNOW, unhurried and never far back while three wide, fanned six wide for the drive, had aim but wasn't good enough. CABERNEIGH went up early to press front-running SPICE HOUSE three or four wide, took over from that one nearing the lane, edged clear, then couldn't sustain the needed momentum. YOUR ROUND stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. FIRE LOOKOUT, in a striking position while three or four wide, was bumped by the winner entering the upper stretch and flattened out thereafter. WOODLAND FLOOD failed to rally and was five wide in the stretch run. SPICE HOUSE moved to the fore two wide, accomplished a dawdling pace to the head of the stretch and weakened gradually.
