GUTSY CALL set a clear pace toward the inside, was collared after a half, was headed a furlong out, but fought back gamely to prevail narrowly. NOTORIETY was allowed to settle, launched a bold bid circling four wide, forged command with a furlong to run but was unable to match strides with the winner. PLEASANT RUN was allowed to settle, angled out four wide and finished willingly to earn the show. SOUR was unhurried into stride, got through and was making up ground too late. TAPAWAY was unhurried, circled six wide and finished with a belated gain. NIGHT PARTY was allowed to settle, moved up five wide to make his bid but failed to sustain the drive. DUCAL tracked the pace two wide to the stretch and faded. NIEDERZEL was hustled along five wide while never far back to the stretch and retreated. DAVID D contended between horses to the final furlong and dropped out. GUNMAN settled between horses and lacked a response when asked. BISCOTTO was forwardly placed along the inside through the second turn and stopped. WHY PRETEND was through early.
