SECOND STREET CITY vied for the lead along the inside and proved best under pressure. NINA FEVER alternated for the lead off the inside but was outfinished. RATOATH SPECIAL close up along the inside, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. TOUCH SCREEN within striking distance three wide, angled out late on the turn but had nothing left late. STORM CLOUD COMING within reach of the lead along the inside, lacked a rally. GOLDEN PHOENIX unprepared at the start, rushed inside, steadied near the five furlong marker then tired in the drive. HUNT FOR COLLEEN outrun off the inside, angled out for the drive, steadied once in the stretch then could not menace. DAZZLE HER was no factor. LAY UP behind the leaders three wide, faded.
