Footnotes

MORYBA (BRZ) settled in hand toward the inside, shifted out and responded when roused with five-sixteenths to run, came four wide, reeled in the leader inside the furlong marker and held stubbornly to keep BLUES STREET at bay. BLUES STREET was allowed to settle, moved with the winner circling five wide, continued on well but wasn't quite good enough. MIKOSHI stalked the pace three wide, assumed command leaving the second turn, opened clear entering the stretch, weakened during the drive and settled for the minor award. YANKEE FORTUNE attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SPORTY was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and finished with a belated gain. CHEROKEE ARTIST was close up three wide to the stretch and retreated. TIMBUCTO sent clear to set the pace, was collared on the second turn and gave way readily once headed.
