HOOFIT (NZ) settled in hand, tucked in and closed the gap through the turn, got through entering the stretch, poked his head in front a furlong out and fought on gamely to narrowly prevail. AIKENITE was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, made a sweeping move five wide, loomed large entering the stretch, kicked on well but missed by the slimmest of margins. HAMAZING DESTINY was shuffled back between horses early, settled near the tail of the field in hand, angled out six wide and finished willingly to earn the show. FLASHPOINT dueled for the lead off of the inside, but weakened between horses in the final furlong and faded. COOL BULLET tracked the pace three wide, shifted out four wide but lacked the needed late response. SOUTHERN STYLE ranged up toward the inside, was bottled up leaving the turn, worked his way to the outside entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. STERLING OUTLOOK vied for the lead three wide, but came up empty between rivals entering the stretch and dropped out.
