IVY CONNECTION settled in hand, came five wide to make his bid, forged command inside the furlong marker and was all out to just last. PRACTICAL JUSTICE was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, came four wide, got through to the inside of IVY CONNECTION and was getting to that one with every stride. DUELING ALEX was allowed to settle, circled seven wide and was just up to earn the show. COFFEE BOY was jostled at the start, moved up between horses, opened clear entering the stretch but faltered in the drive and gave way. ENERGIZED was allowed to settle, rallied between horses five wide and improved position. LE CHEVALIER was hustled along between horses, angled in leaving the turn, got through but failed to sustain the drive. HARBORPLACE was allowed to settle, circled six wide and finished with a belated gain. GEORGE RAY was slow into stride, angled out but passed only the tiring ones. GRATITAT was hustled along three wide, but came up empty between horses after a half and retreated. RIVERS LEGACY saved ground to no avail. FOUR WEALTH sped clear to set the pace, but bore out through the turn and stopped. TERUBCHEH was close up five wide for a half and dropped out.
