

FAMOUS AGAIN settled in behind the dueling leaders early, saved ground for a half, came out four wide nearing the stretch to advance, took over and was under intermittent lefthanded urging thereafter. HUNTER PEAK, eight wide during the opening quarter, edged in a bit on the turn, rallied six wide into the stretch and was second best. ROBIN DE NEST went up early to press front-running COASTAL ACCOUNT from the outside, held on well into the stretch but lacked a closing bid. GOLDEN NICOLAS forced the pace three or four wide into the final furlong, then lacked a closing bid while maintaining his position. TWO POINT TWO MILL, five wide on the backstretch while outrun, came out eight abreast to secure room for the stretch run but lacked a closing response. COASTAL ACCOUNT drifted in at the start, gained the lead, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. SHELBY LANE also drifted in at the break, raced forwardly along the inside until the stretch and tired. MEADOW PLACE failed to menace. SOLDIERS FORTUNE tired upon going a half. RESIGNATION was done early. STAR EYED was never close.
