STAKES Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

For two year olds. By subscription of \$400 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$4,000 to enter and start. Fillies 118 lbs.; Colts and Geldings, 121 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lane's End Breeders' Futurity will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen horses pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to those nominees that have accumulated the highest earnings. Same owner entry cannot start to the exclusion of a single entry. The first four finishers in the Lane's End Breeders' Futurity are automatically made eligible for the Toyota Blue Grass Stakes of 2001 as to nomination fee.



Footnotes

ARABIAN LIGHT, bumped at the start and forced out in tight quarters by SPECTACULAR CAT, was steadied and dropped in behind horses, saved ground until midway of the backstretch, moved out five wide to secure room, commenced a sweeping run five abreast on the second turn, wrested command approaching the stretch, drew off, then was ridden out the remainder. DOLLAR BILL settled inside soon after the start, was unhurried to the far turn, came out six wide to make his run nearing the stretch, wasn't a threat to the winner but outgamed HOLIDAY THUNDER for second. HOLIDAY THUNDER, well placed inside from early on, eased out a bit on the backstretch, lacked room behind rivals at the half-mile ground, was checked again entering the stretch while seeking room between rivals, split foes four wide a sixteenth out but couldn't offer a serious response thereafter. BURNING ROMA, bumped at the start and forced in, settled in behind foes early, lacked room at the half-mile ground, came out five wide for the drive and improved position. MONGOOSE, within striking distance while outside horses, attempted to lug in around the second turn and into the stretch, then failed to rally. MEETYOUATHEBRIG, squeezed in a bit tight at the start, quickly recovered to gain the lead inside, dueled with UNBRIDLED TIME, was headed by that one on the second turn and weakened gradually. STARBURY, squeezed a bit in tight at the start, raced in hand five wide, moved with the winner on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. CLEVER THORNE wasn't a factor while four or five wide much of the way. SPECTACULAR CAT broke out at the start bumping the winner, saved ground from early on, moved up along the inside at the end of the backstretch but weakened soon after entering the second turn. UNBRIDLED TIME stumbled at the start, leaned in bumping BURMING ROMA, went up soon after to vie for the lead outside of MEETYOUATHEBRIG, put a head in front briefly on the second turn, then tired soon after.
