**Footnotes**

SUMMERLY moved to the fore early, maneuvered near the inside, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and widened under energetic hand urging. DOTTIE BOOTH, never far back, followed the winner inside into the lane and couldn't threaten as second best. CONDUCT, close up inside early, bore out on the first turn, continued four wide while following the leaders into the stretch and was empty. ROYAL EPIC, nicely placed between foes from the beginning, offered an earnest bid outside the winner on the far turn but was empty when straightened into the stretch. CHARACTER BUILDER, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch and failed to continue. MOODY WOMAN, sluggish early, settled inside, then improved position while not a threat. WINNING SEASON, five or six wide throughout, weakened soon after going six furlongs. PISTOLS FLOWER, five or six wide throughout, tired approaching the stretch. BABY NEEDS SHOES, five wide, tired on the far turn. MOTHER SUPERIOR, close up early, was steadied sharply on the first turn behind CONDUCT when that one bore out and gradually weakened. DANSEUR CHAUD bobbed at the start, never was a factor and gave way steadily in the drive.
