**Footnotes**

HOST (CHI) broke a bit awkwardly, came in bumping DURBAN THUNDER (BRZ), was unhurried and settled four or five wide, exchanged bumps with THREE VALLEYS entering the first turn, remained well off the inside throughout, advanced six abreast into the lane and wore down VANDERLIN (GB) in the late going. VANDERLIN (GB) stalked the pace from the outset while four wide, moved to challenge nearing the final furlong, reached the front, then failed to contain the winner's surge. GULCH APPROVAL, briefly in front after the start, allowed the lead to DURBAN THUNDER (BRZ), eased out to press that one four wide, inched to challenge on the far turn, gained a slight edge, then weakened in the final furlong. REMIND, within easy striking distance always and five wide, moved with the winner while inside that one entering the lane and wasn't good enough. THREE VALLEYS exchanged bumps with the winner entering the first turn, raced within easy striking distance, was between foes five wide into the final furlong and failed to fire. AD VALOREM, outrun to the stretch, swung out seven or eight wide for the drive and improved position. SEEKING ANSWERS (IRE) never menaced. ALINGHI (AUS) tired on the far turn. DURBAN THUNDER (BRZ), bumped by the winner at the start, went up soon after to gain the lead, raced three or four wide, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and weakened. COOL CONDUCTOR tired on the far turn.
