SECESSIONIST settled in hand off of the inside, commenced his bid between horses near the five-sixteenths pole, angled out four wide leaving the turn, wore down DEADLY CATCH and gradually edged clear. DEADLY CATCH attended the pace along the inside, split rivals entering the stretch, was unable to resist the winner but kept on well to hold the place. BAZINE was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling six wide and was along in time to earn the show. GIARIXA was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. JUDGE BILL settled in the second flight, got through to make a mild bid, steadied inside the three-sixteenths pole, altered course out off of the rail and was making up ground once clear. INSANDOUTS set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed nearing the furlong marker and gave way. RAY FROM CLAY was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to seriously threaten. BUZZ TOWN saved ground to no avail. GOLD AWARD failed to respond. PAPA JIGGS was forwardly placed three wide for a half and tired. FULL RECOVERY pressed the pace three wide for a half and stopped.
