MYSTERIOUSLAKELADY attended the pace along the inside, took closer order after a half, reeled in MUD CREEK inside the furlong marker and edged clear late. MUD CREEK opened clear to dictate terms, proved unable to to match strides with the winner then was all out to just hold the place. TIAMO BELLA settled saving ground, advanced along the inside through the second turn, worked her way out and around a tiring rival entering the stretch, dropped back to the inside and was making up ground. BOZENA was close up three wide, dropped off of the pace after a half, came again five wide and improved position. MINTS N THE VALLEY tucked in to save ground, got through and moved up to make a mild bid through the second turn, but faltered in the drive and faded. LIZZIE K was unhurried into stride, came three wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. CRIMSON DOON failed to respond. FAR EAST chased the pace two wide for six furlongs and tired. BETTY BYE was through after a half.
