CHEROKEE TRIANGLE settled under a snug hold along the inside, commenced his bid between horses, angled out three wide, drew even with a furlong to run and edged clear late. DR. ALEX settled saving ground, advanced between horses through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished well to earn the place. CAJUN PRIZE attended the pace along the inside, moved up between horses after a half, disputed the issue to the final furlong but lacked the needed late response. HYRACOTHERIUM was unhurried into stride, was bumped near the half mile marker when LOVESMELOVESMENOT veered in, angled out to make a late rally but was left with too much to do. HABITUAL broke slow and was shuffled back at the start, settled along the inside, got through to make his bid, waited in traffic inside the five-sixteenths pole, got through and was making up ground too late. TIZ LATE opened clear to set the pace, but faltered entering the stretch and gave way. SPIRITUS chased the pace three wide for six furlongs and tired. SPICY DUBAI angled in to save ground, but lacked a response when called upon. LOVESMELOVESMENOT was hung wide, veered in and bumped HYRACOTHERIUM near the half mile marker and showed little thereafter. RUNNIN DA FENCES failed to respond. MR. SOUL contended four wide for five furlongs and retreated. NATIVE YELL

was forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn and dropped out.
