STAKES Woodford S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2011 allowed 2 lbs; \$36,000 twice since February 14, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 since April 23, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Woodford will be limited to twelve, two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2010-2011 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 28, 2011 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at the Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

HAVELOCK made a steady advance three wide, shifted out four wide entering the stretch, quickened in the final furlong and edged clear late. PERFECT OFFICER tracked the pace four wide, came five wide to make his bid, drew even with a furlong to run, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner.

COUNTRY DAY settled in hand, ranged up three wide through the turn, continued on well between rivals through a prolonged drive but was kept at bay. UNO DUCKSY was allowed to settle, circled six wide and was making up ground. GREAT ATTACK was close up two wide, angled out four wide leaving the turn but lacked the needed late response. MAGOO disputed the pace three wide, but weakened between horses in the drive and faded. A DIEHL was allowed to settle, swung to the outside for the final furlong and improved position. STREAKIN' MOHICAN was forwardly placed toward the inside to the stretch, but lacked a response when called upon. DESPITE THE ODDS failed to respond. GREAT MILLS prompted the pace between horses to the stretch and retreated. GOLDZAR saved ground to little avail. VARSITY set the pressured pace along the inside through the turn and stopped.
