Footnotes

AMERICAN STYLE pressed front-running CAT TRACKER from early on while three or four wide, took over before going a half, settled into the lane with a clear advantage and increased the margin under energetic handling. CAT TRACKER came out bumping VALET MAN at the start, gained the lead near the inside soon after, lost the edge to the winner on the backstretch, moved outside that one and continued on as second best. LEARNED settled inside early, saved ground until nearing the stretch, swung out five wide for the drive and bested the others while not a threat. WOODMOON hopped a bit at the start, settled inside, raced between foes three or four wide on the far turn and was empty in the drive. SAINT DAMIEN moved in behind horses early, then never rallied while three or four wide into the stretch. DEFERRED COMP stalked the pace four or five wide until the stretch and tired. VALET MAN, bumped at the start by CAT TRACKER, was checked in tight quarters, was again steadied and squeezed back while between rivals nearing the first turn, then never menaced. RACE ON GREEN, five or six wide throughout, was finished upon going a half.
