Footnotes

BOONE'S DIAMOND, hustled to contention inside early, saved ground for a half, eased out three or four wide for the drive, took over in the upper stretch and drove clear. GOLD RUN TYPE vied for the lead early while inside of LINGERIE, took over, held a clear advantage into the stretch and wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. OUR MIMI, three wide while within striking distance, eased out a bit more for the drive but lacked a late account. SMART LOVIN' tracked the pace four wide into the stretch and came up empty. CLEVER MAID, four wide for a half, came wider into the lane and never rallied. LINGERIE broke in front, managed a slight lead while dueling outside of GOLD RUN TYPE early, then weakened approaching the stretch. RARE GLITTER, five or six wide on the backstretch, never was a factor.
