KATY LIED outrun off the rail, moved out and advanced four wide on the second turn, came six wide into the stretch, drifted in a bit with a furlong to go then drew clear late. MODEL'S MEMO outrun early five wide, angled in on the backstretch, advanced off the rail on the second turn, angled out five wide into the stretch, was carried in by the winner in midstretch then finished willingly to be second best. SARAROYAL reserved between rivals, made a run four wide on the second turn, steadied in midstretch when in tight then improved her position late. LADY WYNNNE reserved three wide, moved up in that path entering the stretch, made a run at the leaders in midstretch but weakened. BRAHMS BELLE drifted out at the start and bumped with SPEEDLE BEEDLE, recovered to be forwardly placed, moved up four wide on the second turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but tired late. IN THE FRAME within striking distance off the inside, lacked a rally. FUN STEALER was no threat along the inside. SUNSET BELLE sprinted clear and angled to the inside, vied along the rail, held on well to the final furlong and tired. LADY SEATTLE behind the leaders inside, moved out to the three path on the second turn and faded. SPEEDLE BEEDLE bumped at the start, was outrun. MIKE'S HONEY BUNNY alternated for the lead off the inside and stopped.
