ORDAINED set the pressured pace along the inside, edged clear on the turn, turned back the bid of CALL IN RICH with a furlong to run and gamely led throughout. CALL IN RICH prompted the issue three wide, settled off of the pace on the turn, came again to make a bold bid entering the stretch but was unable to best the determined winner. CAPTAIN GOODENOUGH was forwardly placed between horses, dropped off the leaders and tucked in to save ground on the turn, failed to menace the top two but stayed on well to earn the show. SANTO GATO was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. THUNDEROUS G broke slow, was allowed to settle, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. NEW YORK RUNAWAY was hustled along between horses in mid pack and went evenly. DONE GONE saved ground to no avail. RAY FROM CLAY showed little. FREDERICO settled between horses near the tail of the field and was never a factor.
