Footnotes

TENSKI pressed front-running PRATELLA from early on while under snug restraint, took over from that one on the second turn, drew clear in the upper stretch and was kept to energetic handling. SHIRES ENDE, never far back, followed the leaders five wide into the stretch, loomed prominently outside the winner for the final furlong but couldn't offer the needed response. SIERRA VIRGEN offered a mild gain while no threat to the top two. DARLING ALICE saved ground while well placed into the stretch but came up empty. RECORDING made mild bid in upper stretch to reach contention but flattened out soon after. PRATELLA made the pace three wide and weakened after six furlongs. KIRBY'S SONG followed the leaders four wide while well placed to stretch then tired. SICY D'ALSACE (FR), outrun to the stretch, angled six wide for the drive and failed to respond. WHITE BEAUTY tired early and raced seven wide into the stretch.
