CAPTAIN STEVE sprinted clear off the rail into the first turn, set the pace just off the rail, jumped some float marks on the track near the five furlong marker, recovered and continued to set the pace, responded willingly when set down in upper stretch and drew off late despite hesitating a bit over the marks left by the starting gate near the finish. GRAEME HALL, closest to the winner while outside that one, made a run at that one entering the stretch but could not keep pace in the final furlong while best of the others. MILLENCOLIN, taken back a bit and angled in entering the first turn, raced within striking distance along the inside but tired in the drive. IFITSTOBEITSUPTOME lost his action momentarily when five wide and between rivals on the first turn, dropped well back, made a run off the inside on the second turn but could not menace. MR. LIVINGSTON, unhurried early, made a mild gain off the inside on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. NATURE, six wide into the first turn, swerved out and jumped some float marks near the five furlong marker then gave way the final three furlongs. MIGHTY, four wide into the first turn when forwardly placed, continued well for five furlongs and faded. ROCKET CAT, close up early off the inside, stopped after a half and was outdistanced.
