Footnotes

KATHY K D, never far back while racing in behind the leaders under light restraint, angled five wide when straightened for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. HI TECH HONEYCOMB, unhurried early while also racing in behind rivals, eased out six wide entering the second turn, continued well off the inside into the stretch and was going well at the end. SONG OF ANGELS edged inward early to vie for the lead inside of ILLUSIVE PLAY, took over on the second turn, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. YES HONEY, forwardly placed inside from early on, came around ILLUSIVE PLAY nearing the stretch, returned to the inside, gained about even terms for the lead inside of SONG OF ANGELS nearing the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SUMMER MIS, reserved in behind the dueling leaders early, eased out four wide on the backstretch to force the pace, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but came up empty. BROTHER'S BLUFF, outrun from the start and angled inside, saved ground for six furlongs, came out five or six wide for the drive and improved position while unable to menace. MOLLY B WILD broke out at the start, raced five or six wide most of the way, offered a mild bid approaching the final quarter but flattened out in the drive. ILLUSIVE PLAY moved up early to gain a slim lead while dueling outside of SONG OF ANGELS, lost the edge to that one leaving the backstretch, held on well for six furlongs and faded. SKORCH never was prominent.
